

Your questions answered about our new and improved Pathology Service. Your feedback is so important in how we shape our healthcare service.

- Q. Why did GORH change providers?
- A. The pathology contract required updating and the services was put out to tender as required. The successful tender was Dorevitch and this required a change in the process.
- Q. Is the service still the same?
- A. The service is different, it is now more timely and reliable, with GP's often being able to take blood during the consultations.
